THESE ORNATELY DECORATED CEREMONIAL PADDLE CLUBS WERE EXCESSIVELY BROAD, ALMOST FAN LIKE AND WERE MADE FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF CHIEFS AND PRIESTS. THEY WERE OFTEN HANDED DOWN AS HEIRLOOMS AND LONG USE HAS WORN AWAY SOME OF THE DESIGN AND PRODUCED A SMOOTH PATINA ACROSS THE SURFACE.

FIJIAN CLUBS WERE NOT ONLY USED IN WARFARE WHICH WAS THE MAIN OCCUPATION OF FIJIAN SOCIETY, BUT ALSO FOR DANCING, THE ENTERTAINMENT OF VISITORS AND IN SPORT. HOWEVER CLUBS SUCH AS THIS WERE RESERVED FOR RITUAL USE, ALTHOUGH KAEPPLER STATES FROM THE STONE AGE TO THE SPACE AGE IN 200 YEARS'; PAGE: 28, THAT THESE CLUBS WERE ALSO USED BY CHIEFS AND PRIESTS TO DEFLECT ARROWS ON THE BATTLEFIELD.
