THE MUSEUM LABEL WITH THIS CLUB READS : 'THIS WEAPON WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR TWO MURDERS ON THE GOLD COAST (GHANA) IN 1920 . A NATIVE RAN AWOK AND MURDERED HIS NEIGHBOUR, THEN TOOK SHELTER IN THE BUSH . A SERGEANT IN THE GOLD COAST DEFENCE FORCE WAS SENT TO ARREST HIM, BUT WAS HIMSELF BRUTALLY HIT ON THE HEAD AND HIS SKULL BROKEN . THE FORCE OF THE BLOW CAUSED THE SPLIT IN THE WOOD OF THE WEAPON . PRESENTED TO THE MUSEUM BY MRS E BRADDICK, WHOSE HUSBAND WAS DISTRICT COMMISSIONER .'
